- APEC Common Principles to Shipping Policy was adopted by MI group at the 24th TPT-WG in 2004
- APEC member economies have adopted the 9 set of common shipping policy principles to encourage free and competitive access to international liner shipping markets, maritime auxiliary and intermodal services.
