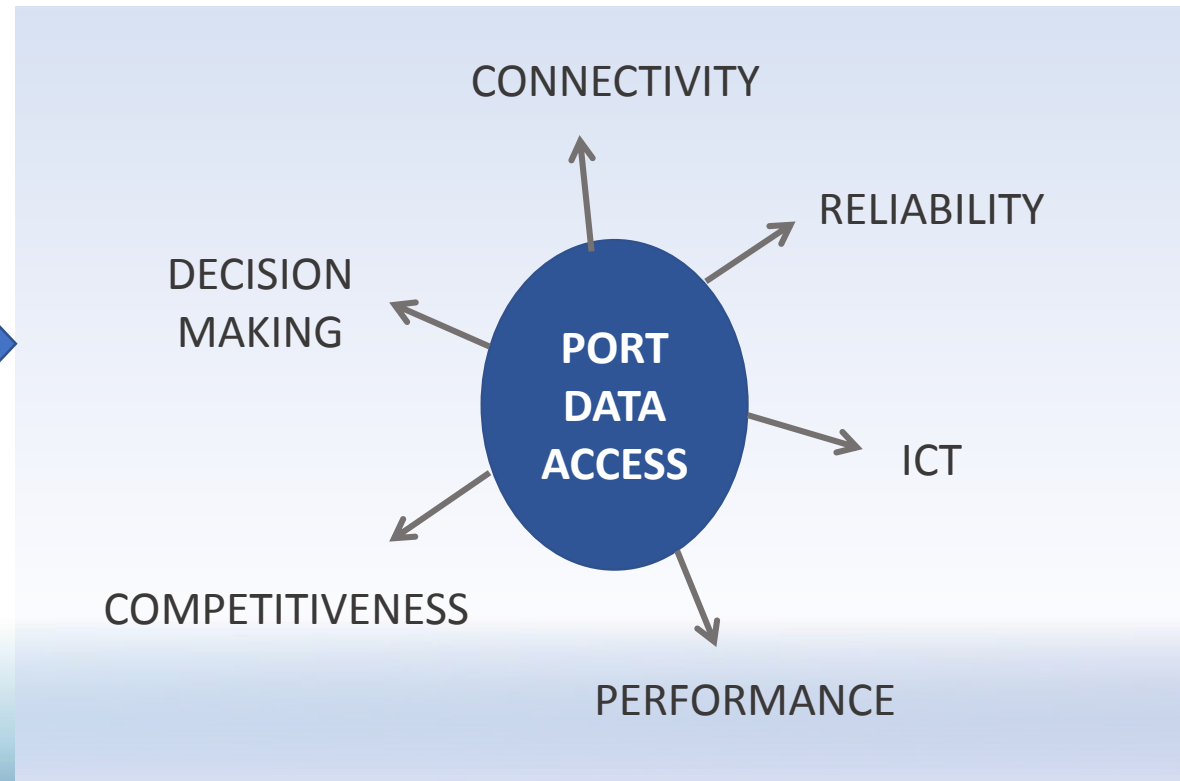

- Integral connectivity

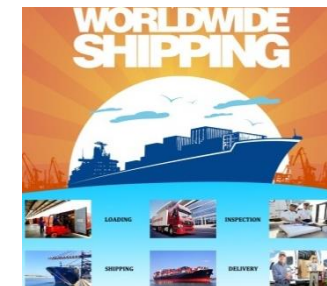

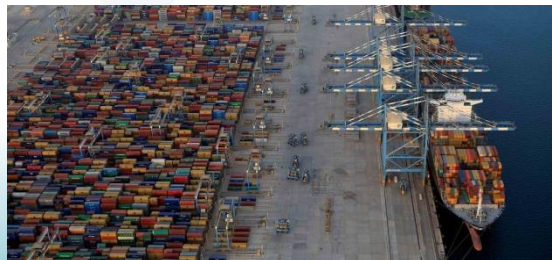

## Proposed Tool

- A platform shared by all economies, that acts as an interface between both the maritime and land environments.

## Management

- At the local level: Port authorities.
- At the international level: A global port services network.
- Administration of platform: shifts work on a rotational basis.
- Volunteer managers are welcome.

## Characteristics

- Define indicators of shared information.
- Voluntary participation.
- Stakeholders' commitment.
- Formalization through Cooperation agreements.
