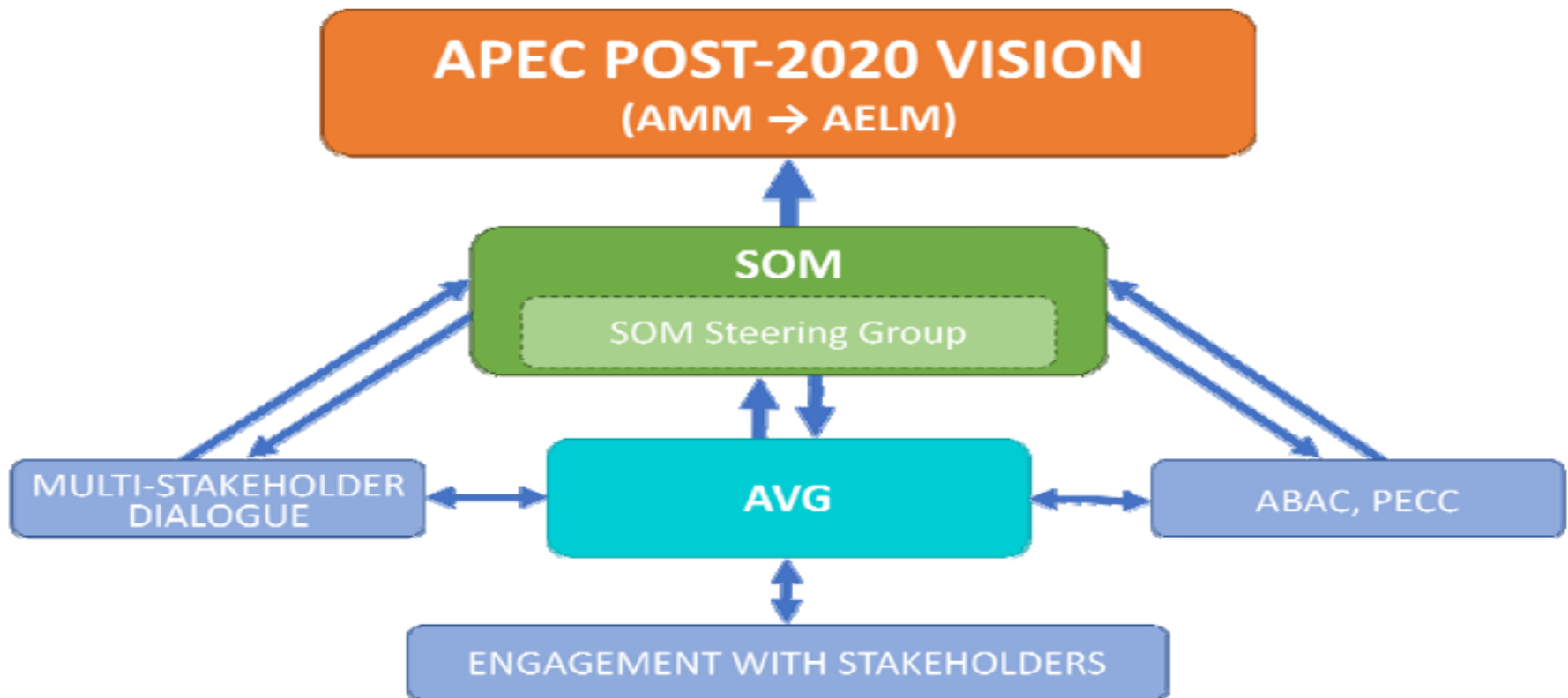

# Key Points in AVG process



- APEC Senior Officials commit to lead and oversee the process of developing **APEC post-2020 vision** and report to Ministers and Leaders for consideration and endorsement by the end of 2020.
- Senior Officials hereby establish an **APEC Vision Group (AVG)** as an advisory body
  - A Senior Official (SOM)-level Steering Group: Peru, Vietnam, Papua New Guinea, Chile, Malaysia, New Zealand and Thailand
- AVG will deliver a **report** to Senior Officials by CSOM 2019 with recommendations on a post-2020 vision.
- **APEC Committees, Working Groups, fora and sub-fora may provide inputs, including visions for APEC cooperation in their respective areas of work.**

# Key Timeline



## **2018 - 2019:**

- January 2018: Launch of nomination process to be completed by SOM 2, 2018
- SOM2/2018: First meeting of AVG.
- SOM3/2019: Draft AVG Report submitted to SOM.
- CSOM/2019: Final AVG Report submitted to SOM.

## **2020:**

- Drawing on the AVG's recommendations, SOMs formulate an APEC Post-2020 Vision.
- Leaders announce the APEC Post-2020 Vision.
